

## GENERAL INFORMATION

Classes are limited to six students per instructor. When you have successfully completed the BRC or ERC you will:

- 🏍️ Be exempted from the written and riding test requirement for your motorcycle endorsement at the Department of Motor Vehicles.
- 🏍️ Receive a Motorcycle Safety Foundation completion card.
- 🏍️ Be eligible to receive discounts or partial course reimbursement from participating motorcycle manufacturers and on motorcycle riding gear and accessories from participating dealers.



## BASIC RIDER COURSE

The Basic Rider Course is a complete course of instruction for those age 16 years and older who wish to develop safe motorcycle street-riding skills. Participants must possess a valid driver's license or permit. The course consists of approximately eight hours of classroom preparation and ten hours of challenging motorcycle riding activities. This provides the students with "first-hand" experience in various maneuvers which will help prepare them for the demands of street riding. No prior experience is necessary and **motorcycles are provided** by Cycle School of Florida, Inc. This course is required for motorcycle license applicants under 21 and recommended for anyone wishing to learn riding strategies to reduce their risk on the road.

## EXPERIENCED RIDER COURSE

The Experienced Rider Course (ERC) is a one-day course of instruction for people 21 and older who already own and ride a motorcycle and are interested in state-of-the-art motorcycle handling techniques and brushing up on street riding skills. ERC participants must be confident of their riding skills and possess a motorcycle learner's permit or endorsement. You will be riding your own motorcycle during the course so it must pass a safety inspection. **Proof of valid motorcycle insurance** is required. The student accepts all risks associated with riding during the course.

## FIRST TIME?

Never ridden? Not sure you can or should do it? Try our **FIRST TIME RIDE**. This two-hour introduction to motorcycling allows you to experience motorcycling in a small group, low stress environment under the supervision and direction of our friendly and helpful coaches. If you try it and like it, you can sign up for the Basic Rider Course!

## BASIC REQUIREMENTS

All participants **must** be in **good physical condition** and be able to ride a bicycle. These courses can be strenuous. If you have poor balance or difficulty with coordination, perhaps riding a motorcycle is not for you.

During riding sessions, participants must wear a DOT approved helmet (loaners are available), full-fingered gloves, long sleeve shirt, eye protection, long pants and sturdy, over-the-ankle footwear.
